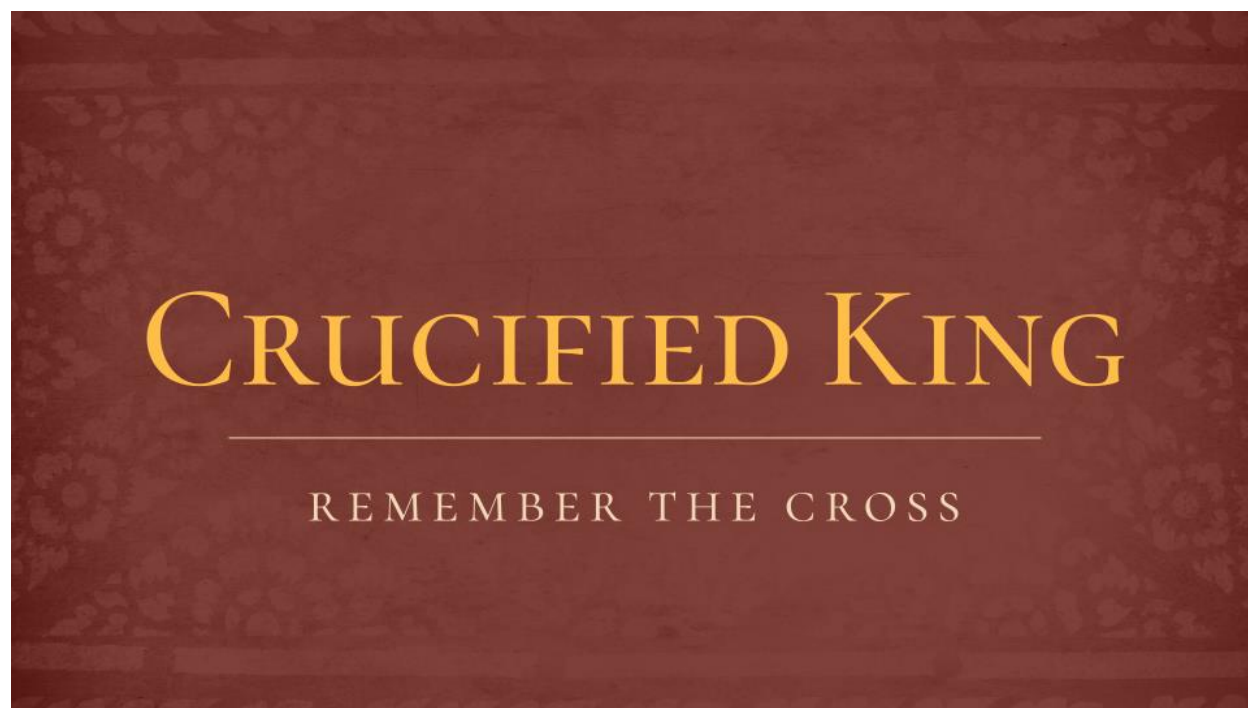

PRESENTING & PROMOTING THIS THEME
