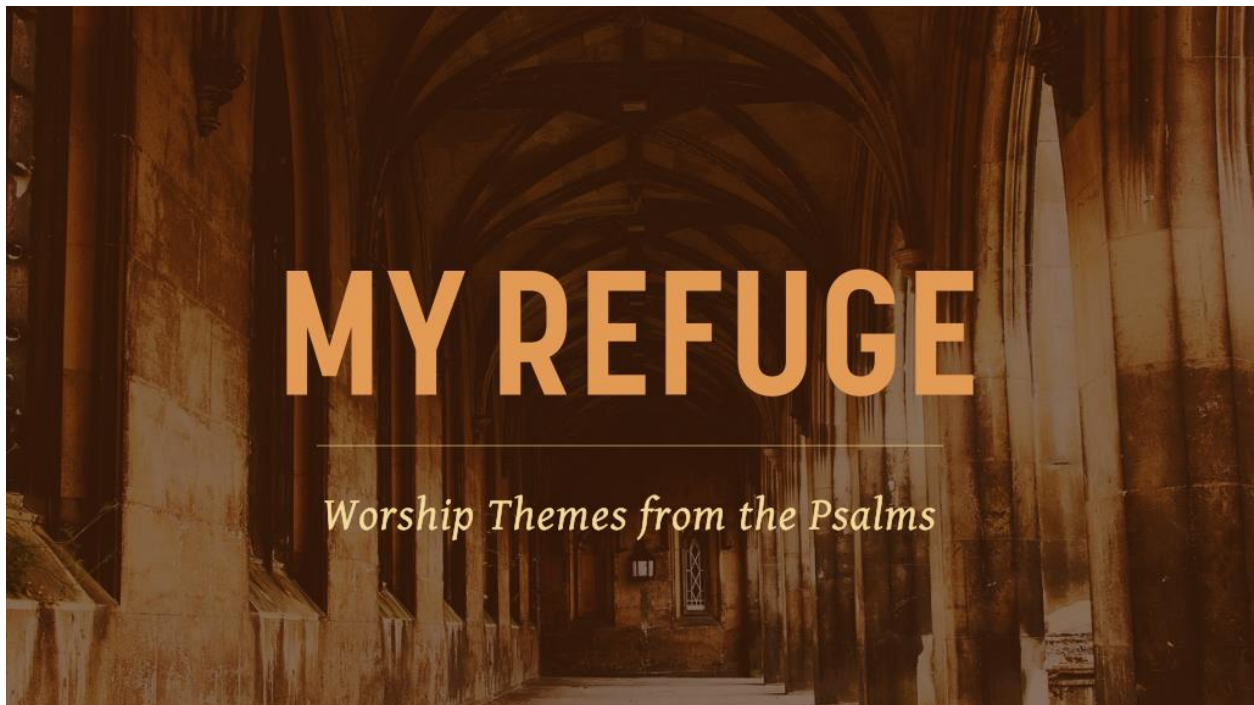


MY REFUGE
